



## AMPS Online Course Orientation and Outline

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### Course objectives

During this AMPS certification course, you will learn to do the following:

- Administer and score the AMPS in a valid and reliable manner
- Interpret the results of an AMPS observation from criterion- and norm-referenced perspectives
- Use the AMPS to promote occupation-centered and client-centered practice
- Use AMPS results as evidence demonstrating the effectiveness of interventions

### Materials needed

You will need the following materials during **every** module of this course:

- AMPS Manual, Volumes 1 and 2
- Highlighter
- Pen or pencil
- Sticky notes or page markers to denote key sections of the manual
- Blank paper for taking notes
- AMPS Score Forms (found in *Online Course Files*)

### Course format

During this AMPS training and certification course, you will complete readings from the AMPS manual and participate in video lessons. ***The video lessons do not replace careful reading of the AMPS manual.*** During several of the video lessons, you will need to use your AMPS manual to answer questions, score video cases, and submit your scores for feedback. Throughout the course, you will receive individualized feedback to help you improve your scoring.

### Course length and contact hours

This AMPS training and certification course will take approximately 25 hours. You have 30 days to complete the course from the day you first sign into the online AMPS course.

## Rater calibration and certification

After you complete all lessons of the online AMPS course, the data analysts at the Center for Innovative OT Solutions will analyze your finalized scores from the online course scoring cases. These analyses involve determining your personal severity as an AMPS rater based on how lenient or strict you were scoring the online video cases in relation to all other calibrated and certified AMPS raters. Once your analyses are complete, CIOTS will contact you by email with a new, full AMPS OTAP license key. Enter this new OTAP license key into your OTAP software to generate AMPS reports for the people that you test using the AMPS.
